I am re-listing this beautiful piece of art because the winner of the last auction turned out to be a fraud. Rule one: overseas buyers are not to be trusted and I am eBay. Other long-time eBay sellers tell me, eBay is crawling with criminals and that having a dirtbag put in a winning bid is common. See last graph for more.

I have received some wonderful emails about the car and I want to acknowledge those. One example: "It is a beautiful car. I wish I had the money and the space the fall and was amazed at all the "experts" that knew more about my car than I did. I wondered if my car was such a pile, why they were so interested in it? I tota set my reserve. People thought they could get it for 10 grand? give me a break. I could not buy the suspension for that. Good luck in selling your car. Be Careful. I was (\$73,100)."

This two and a half year project presents over \$140k invested (all receipts) and a beautiful blend of the old and new. The car was purchased from Wes at Woodi somewhat tired original condition. The sheet metal and frame (zero rust) were perfect, but a new, modern power train and overall technology update were desire current level of enjoyment.

I've had installed a brand new, complete independent front end suspension and power steering conversion by Art Morrison containing a mandrel-formed 2"x4" rect welded steering and lower control arm attachments, spindles, sway bar, upper mounts, tubular control arms, ball joints, linkage and all brand new required hardwar shocks. The car steers with one finger.

The car also has a complete, new air conditioning system by Vintage Air with under dash controls; new, gorgeous custom upholstery on original seats done in plus seats, doors and side walls; the headliner is done in rich, durable, easily cleanable naugahyde; the entire flooring is done in beautiful brown German square weave hand-painted wood grainfinish on the dash, all interior window frames and the outside of the upper and lower tailgates; complete new chrome on the original grill a sides of car.
